

THE INDIAN INSTITUTES OF TECHNOLOGY JOINT ENTRANCE EXAMINATION (IIT-JEE)

Admission of Indian nationals to undergraduate Programmes like B.Tech/ B.Pharm/Integrated M.Sc., and M.Tech Courses in any one of the IIT's at Madras, Guwahati, New Delhi, Mumbai, Kanpur, Kharagpur and Roorkee, is made through the Joint Entrance Examination conducted by the IIT every year. The Indian School of Mines, Dhanbad and the Institute of Technology, Banaras Hindu University, Varanasi also admit students from the JEE Merit List to their undergraduate Programmes.

Pattern of Examination*

The pattern of the JEE has been changed from JEE 2007. The JEE now consists of a single examination with two papers (Paper 1 and Paper 2), each of three hours' duration. Both Paper 1 and Paper 2 will each have three separate sections on Physics, Chemistry and Mathematics. Both the papers will be of the objective type, designed to test the students' comprehension and analytical ability.

Eligibility for writing the IIT-JEE 2009 *

- (i) All Indian and foreign nationals seeking admission to the IIT's must write the JEE.
- (ii) Candidates appearing in the 10+2 or equivalent exam in 2008 or 2009 must secure at least 60% marks in aggregate in their respective Board Examinations. There is a 5% relaxation for SC/ST and PD candidates.

If the respective Boards award letter grades, without providing a norm for converting them to equivalent percentage marks, the norms decided by the Joint Implementation Committee of the JEE will be final.

- (iii) A candidate is allowed only two attempts to write the JEE. He/She will be allowed to write the JEE only in the year in which he/she passes the qualifying examination and/or in the following year.

*Based on the Notification published for IIT-JEE, 2008.

- (iv) Candidates who have joined any of the IITs, IIT-BHU, Varanasi or ISM, Dhanbad through the JEE, will not be permitted to appear for the JEE again.
- (v) The date of birth of a candidate intending to write the IIT-JEE in 2009 must fall on or after October 01, 1984. There is a five year relaxation in the upper age limit for SC/ST/PD candidates whose date of birth must fall on or after October 01, 1979.

Qualifying Examinations:

Candidates appearing for the JEE in 2009 should have either completed or be appearing in 2009 for any one of the following:

- (i) The final examination of the 10+2 system, conducted by any recognized Central/State Board, such as Central Board of Secondary Education, New Delhi; Council for Indian School Certificate Examination, New Delhi; etc.
- (ii) Intermediate or two-year Pre-University Examination conducted by a recognized Board/University.
- (iii) Final Examination of the two-year course of the Joint Services Wing of the National Defence Academy.
- (iv) General Certificate Education (GCE) Examination (London/Cambridge/Sri Lanka) at the Advanced (A) level.
- (v) High School Certificate Examination of the Cambridge University.
- (vi) Any Public School/Board/University Examination in India or in any foreign country recognized by the Association of Indian Universities as equivalent to 10+2 system.
- (vii) H.S.C. Vocational Examination.
- (viii) Senior Secondary School Examination conducted by the National Open School with a minimum of five subjects.
- (ix) 3 or 4-year Diploma recognized by AICTE or a State Board of Technical Education.

In case the relevant qualifying examination is not a public examination, the candidate must have passed at least one public (Board of Pre-University) examination at an earlier level.

OUR PREPARATORY PROGRAMMES FOR IIT-JEE, 2009

Syllabus and Medium of Instruction

The course material is in the English medium, and only students who can follow our lessons in English should apply for enrolment.

Progressive Evaluation Tests

Progressive Evaluation Tests - Postal

There will be three Postal Tests, (Papers I and II) with questions in each of the three subjects, Physics, Mathematics and Chemistry. These objective papers, modeled on the IIT-JEE pattern, will be sent with each of Sets 2, 4 and 6.

Students should self-administer the Tests strictly under examination conditions, and finish each paper in one sitting within the specified time limit, without referring to the study materials.

Complete solutions to each of the papers will also be sent with the subsequent Sets, for **self-evaluation** by the student.

Progressive Evaluation Test – National Sit-down

There will be one National Sit-down Test, conducted at 43 cities across the country. consisting of Paper I and II, to provide our students with feedback on their progress in preparing for the IIT-JEE.

The Test is scheduled for **August** 2008. The answer papers will be evaluated and a Percentile score given to every student in order to give an idea of where he/she stands with regard to the national competition during preparation for the IIT-JEE.

B.MAT National Sit-down Tests

B.MAT – Part Tests

There will be six B.MAT Part Tests conducted in 43 cities across the country. Each of these six Tests will cover selected topics in Physics, Maths and Chemistry to enable the student to thoroughly assess his level of preparation, topic-wise.

The first two B.MAT Part Tests are scheduled for September 2008, the second and the third for October 2008, and the last two tests for November 2008.

B.MAT – Full Syllabus Tests

To help students prepare thoroughly for the IIT-JEE, eight B.MAT Full-Syllabus Tests will be conducted in 43 cities under exact IIT-JEE conditions. The first two Tests are scheduled for December 2008 and the next two for January 2009. Tests 5 and 6 will be in February 2009 and the last two in March 2009 after the Std. XII Board Exams.

At each Test, students will be administered two 3-hour Objective-type Test Papers. Each Paper will have separate sections (Physics, Maths and Chemistry) and will test the comprehension and analytical ability of the students to give them valuable practice to face the IIT-JEE 2009 in April 2009.

The Question Papers of these Tests will not be sent by Post to students who do not appear in these Tests.

B.MAT – PERFORMANCE EVALUATION

Answer papers for all the fourteen Sit-down Tests will be evaluated and every student who appears for these tests will be given his/her individual percentile score so that they know their relative performance against the national competition.

IIT-JEE Simulator Series

Ten Full-Syllabus IIT-JEE Simulator Papers, based on the new IIT-JEE pattern, with sealed solutions, will be sent to our postal students. Students should self-administer each of these Simulator Test Papers under strict examination conditions, closely following the instructions in the papers, and then evaluate their performance by comparing their answers with the solutions provided in the accompanying sealed envelopes.

This home-based Simulator Test Series, plus the B.MAT Sit-down Test Series (which will be conducted in 43 cities between December 2008 and March 2009) will give students the cumulative experience of having sat through 18 IIT-JEE Tests before appearing for the actual IIT-JEE 2009. This experience will build up speed, precision and a test-taking mind-set to help students face the IIT-JEE with supreme self-confidence.

Note:

*The first 2 home-based IIT-JEE Simulator Test Papers will be sent on enrolment or in November/ December 2008 whichever is later. The next five Test Papers will be sent **ONLY** when we receive a photocopy of the student's IIT-JEE 2009 **Application Form showing the Application Number**. The last three Test Papers will be sent **ONLY** on our receiving a photocopy of the student's **Hall Ticket** for the IIT-JEE 2009, clearly showing the Registration Number and with the photograph visible.*

CONTACT PROGRAMMES

The first Programme will be in August/September 2008 and the second in December/January 2009. Students will be notified in advance about the exact dates and venues of these programmes.

Contact Programmes will be held in: Bangalore, Bokaro Steel City, Chandigarh, Chennai, Hyderabad, Kochi, Kolkata, Lucknow, Mumbai, Nagpur, New Delhi, Patna, Pune and Ranchi.

Contact Programmes and Tests

The Enrolment Form provides separate columns listing the Centres for our Contact Programmes and National Sit-down Tests. Students should indicate the Centre of their choice separately for the Contact Programmes and National Sit-down Tests.

No change in the Centre is normally allowed. Any subsequent change in the Centre allotted will be considered only in exceptional cases and only if the student applies to us in advance and receives our written approval.

Students who enrol late may miss one or more of the Contact Programmes and/or Sit-down Tests, depending on the date of enrolment.

Students will be eligible to appear for the Sit-down Tests thirty days after the date of enrolment.

Doubt Letter Scheme

Our Professors' services are readily available to clear students' difficulties while studying our course material. Students are welcome to send to us, in writing, their doubts, up to March 15, 2009 even if our entire course material was received much earlier.

Problems must be restricted to less than 5 per letter and be well within the examination syllabus. The source from which the problems have been taken **MUST BE SPECIFIED and the student's working sheets must be enclosed. Problems/questions published in magazines for awards, will not be replied to, if sent to us as doubt letters.**

Doubt Letters which do not meet these specific conditions will be returned unanswered.

PROCEDURE FOR ENROLMENT

Enrolment

Enrolment for the Postal Courses for IIT-JEE, 2009 will open on January 01, 2008 with despatch commencing in April 2008.

Late Enrolment: Those who enrol after October 15, 2008 will be sent all the material in one lot.

Students can enrol at any time convenient to them but are advised to join early to ensure that they get the maximum time for studying and revising the course material.

The student should send to us:

1. The completed Enrolment Form, with a passport size photograph glued to the Enrolment Form in the allotted space.

Note: Enrolment Forms will not be accepted without the photographs.

2. Two additional signed copies (preferably colour) of the photograph with the enrolment form. One photograph will be affixed to the Admit Card sent to the student on enrolment. The Admit Card MUST be produced for admission to the Contact Programmes and the National Sit-down Tests.

NOTE: The examination superintendent at the venue of the National Sit-down Tests and the Manager of the Contact Programmes reserve the right to refuse admission to any student who does not produce the Admit Card.

3. The full course fee.

Fee Remittance: The fee for the course should be remitted **in full**, either by **Money Order or Demand Draft**, drawn in favour of **Brilliant Tutorials Pvt. Ltd.**, payable at **Chennai**.

Students resident outside India should follow the remittance instructions given on the Enrolment Form they receive.

Remittance by Money Order: The course for which the M.O. is being sent, as well as the student's full postal address, should be indicated in the coupon.

- * Merely reading through worked-out solutions is not the way to prepare.
- * You should not need any external prodding, since you have your own goal to reach.
