### OPPORTUNITIES FOR MEDICAL EDUCATION

More than Twenty Thousand Seats are available every year in Indian Medical Colleges. The entrance examinations are many and the competition tough. Yet a bright and hardworking student *can* with our guidance be selected by several Medical Colleges from which to choose the one he/she wants to attend.

A student can appear for several Entrance Examinations in the same year. In fact, every year, most of our students appear for two or more Entrance Exams and are selected for admission by more than one Medical College, from which they then choose the Institution they want to join.

## **OVERVIEW**

The National level Medical Entrance Tests are open to students without reference to their place of domicile. Medical Entrance Tests conducted at the State level are meant for students of State domicile. The basic requirement is that students should be at least 17 years old on or before 31st December of the year of admission; the upper age limit where prescribed is 25 years. Candidates must have completed Std. XII or its equivalent examination with Physics, Chemistry and Biology.

### ***I. NATIONAL-LEVEL MEDICAL ENTRANCE EXAMINATIONS***

#### **(i) All India Pre-Medical Pre-Dental Test (AIPMT)\***

The AIPMT is conducted by the Central Board of Secondary Education (CBSE) every year, for admission to the 15% merit based seats of the total in-take capacity of specified Medical /Dental Colleges located in all States **except** Andhra Pradesh and Jammu & Kashmir. Candidates belonging to these two states are not eligible for admission to the AIPMT. If they claim eligibility they must produce an affidavit in the form prescribed that (a) they are not eligible to seek admission to Medical Colleges of Andhra Pradesh /Jammu & Kashmir and

(b) they are not domiciled in Andhra Pradesh or Jammu & Kashmir.

#### ***Eligibility and Qualifications for AIPMT***

- Only Indian Nationals are eligible.
- The candidate must have completed 17 years of age on or before December 31st of the year of admission.
- The upper age limit is 25 years on 31st December of the year of the Entrance Examination (30 years for candidates of SC/ST/OBC)
- The number of attempts which a candidate can avail shall be limited to 3 (three) for all candidates.

- The minimum qualification is a pass in the 12th standard of the 10 +2 course (Higher/Senior Secondary Exams or 2nd year if Pre/Intermediate pre-degree Exam) in the subjects of Physics, Chemistry Biology and English individually; a minimum of 50% marks taken together in PCB (40% in the case of SC/ST/OBC candidates) is required. Those who are taking the Std XII examination whose result is awaited may also appear for the Entrance Examination subject to their fulfilling the conditions later.

### ***Pattern of AIPMT***

The Entrance Examination consists of :

- **A Preliminary Examination** in April consisting of one paper containing 200 objective type questions from Physics, Chemistry and Biology ( Botany & Zoology) of three hours' duration.
- **A Final Examination** in May only for those who qualify in the Preliminary Examination, consisting of two papers, each of 2 hours' duration. Paper 1 will contain questions from Physics and Chemistry and Paper 2 will contain question from Biology (Botany & Zoology). The Final Exam will have conventional (non objective) type of questions.

### **(ii) Other Medical Entrance Examinations**

There are several Medical Colleges where seats are open to Indian Nationals through Entrance Examinations without any domicile conditions, some of which are:

- St. John's National Academy of Health Science, Bangalore
- Bharati Vidyapeeth, Pune.
- Dr. Ramachandra Medical College & Research Institute, Chennai
- Annamalai University, Tamil Nadu

These other Medical Entrance Examinations are generally conducted between April and August; some examination authorities stipulate higher minimum/aggregate marks in English and for Physics, Chemistry & Biology taken together

## ***II. STATE MEDICAL TESTS***

A candidate satisfying the domicile conditions of a state can appear for one of the State Medical Tests. In most cases the selection is made through an Entrance Examination conducted for this purpose

#### ***Medium of Instruction***

The course material is in the English medium, and only students who can follow our lessons in English should apply for enrolment.

#### **COURSE HIGHLIGHTS**

Our 2-Year Postal Course for Medical Entrance Examinations has been an outstanding success. It is an integrated course, well suited for the All India Pm/Pd Tests conducted by the CBSE, and the Entrance Exams of almost all Medical Colleges in India, including MHCET as well as the medical segments of Karnataka CET, WBJEE and EAMCET (A.P). This has been made possible by our Professors who study the changing syllabi and patterns of examinations of the various Medical Colleges, on an on-going basis and continuously review and revise the lessons and exercises.

Enrolment to this course is open to students who are entering or studying in Std. XI of the 10 + 2 scheme or equivalent. A student who has completed Std. XI but plans to appear for the Medical Entrance Exams in 2010 may also enrol for this course.

#### ***The Course Material: Lessons and Assignments***

The course material in Physics, Chemistry and Biology (Botany and Zoology) is presented in 14 sets of study packages, seven of which will be despatched in the first year and seven in the second.

The material covers a wide syllabus. The worked examples, the Assignments, the Question Bank and the Self-Scorers help students to prepare for various patterns of examinations. Our B.NET Two-year Test Series, comprising 19 National Sit-down Tests and 23 Full-Syllabus Postal Simulator Tests for Medical Entrance Exams, gives students abundant practice for all Entrance Examinations in addition to the All India Pm/Pd Test.

### ***Assignments***

Each lesson is followed by an Assignment in two parts: Part A containing subjective/descriptive Questions to initiate students into solving problems on the specific topics covered in that lesson; Part B will be Objective Questions on par with the All-India Pm/Pd Test standard.

The Assignments, given at the end of each lesson, in each of the three subjects Physics, Chemistry, and Biology will help students understand the subject, gain practice in solving short and long problems and become familiar with the subject matter of the course.

The student should study the theory well, systematically work the assignments and should then compare his/her working with the fully worked-out solutions which will be provided in the subsequent set.

**Working sheets of assignments should NOT be sent to us.**

### ***Postal Tests***

There will be five sets of Postal Tests modelled on CBSE's Pm/Pd Test during the two year Course: each set of Tests will consist of three papers: i. a 3 - hour objective paper with questions in Physics, Chemistry and Biology. ii a two hour subjective paper in Physics and Chemistry and iii. a two hour subjective paper in Biology.

These Test Papers will be sent with Sets 3, 5, 7, 10 and 12; keys and answers/solutions (where applicable) will be sent with the subsequent set for self-evaluation.

Students should self-administer the Tests strictly under examination conditions, and finish each paper in one sitting within the specified time limit, without referring to the study materials.

### ***MED.QB (MEDICAL QUESTION BANK) AND SELF-SCORERS***

#### ***Med.QB (Medical Question Bank)***

Brilliant's Question Bank for Medical Entrance will be issued as a part of the CBSE-PLUS Course with Set 12. This contains over 4000 objective and subjective questions topic - wise in Physics, Chemistry and Biology, with keys and explanatory notes for select questions.

### ***Self - Scorers***

The Self-Scorers consist of 12 sets of Full-Syllabus Test Papers, each containing 200 objective questions in Physics, Chemistry and Biology with keys. These are to be attempted as Home-based tests and the score arrived at with the help of keys sent. These will be sent with Set 13.

### ***Ready Reference Compendium and Glossary***

### **B.NET National Sit-down Tests**

In the first year, a total of four B.NET Progressive Tests will be conducted for our CBSE-PLUS students. All these are National Sit-down Tests conducted at various centres around the country.

There will be four B.NET Progressive Tests in the second year - one each in August and October 2009, followed by four Part Tests to assess his/her performance in different topics in each subject, during November and December 2009. The B.NET Final Tests will be conducted in December 2009 and January 2010 before the Board Exams, and in April 2010, conveniently after the Std. XII Board Exams and close to the actual Medical Entrance Exams.

\* *Since this will be the final rehearsal test before the actual Pm/Pd Preliminary Test, we will conduct only the Preliminary Test and not the subjective paper tests.*

All the B.NET Sit-down Tests will be based on the CBSE pattern i.e. a three hour Preliminary Test with Objective questions in Physics, Chemistry, and Biology, followed by a Final Exam of two 2-hour subjective papers - Paper I in Physics and Chemistry and Paper II in Biology.

All the B.NET Progressive Tests, Part Tests and the B.NET Final Tests will be evaluated and all the students who appear for these tests will be given their individual Percentile Score to enable them to know their relative performance against the national competition.

**TEST CENTRES:** Ahmedabad, Amritsar, Bangalore, Calicut , Chandigarh, Chennai, Coimbatore, Guwahati, Hyderabad, Kochi, Kolkata, Lucknow, Mumbai, New Delhi, Pune, Patna, and Thiruvananthapuram.

**We will not send the Question Papers of these Tests to students who do not appear in the Tests. Students must be enrolled thirty days before a Test to be eligible to appear for the Test.**

**Full-Syllabus Medical Entrance Simulator Test Series (home-based)**

Twenty three Full-Syllabus Test Papers, simulating the pattern of CBSE's All-India Pm/Pd Test, will be sent to students enrolled in this course. Thirteen of these papers will be sent with Set 14, and the final ten Papers will be sent when we receive a photocopy of the students's Hall Tickets clearly showing the Registration Numbers for the Medical Entrance Examinations for 2010.

These Test Papers contain a total of 3000 objective and subjective type questions. The last ten papers will each consist of 2 Subjective Papers of 2 hours' each: Paper I in Physics and Chemistry and Paper II in Botany and Zoology on the pattern of CBSE's All-India Pm/Pd Final Exam. These ten papers containing 1000 non-objective Questions will fully meet the requirements of CBSE's Pm/Pd Preliminary and Final Examination as well as that of the other Entrance Examinations.

Keys to these Test Papers will be sent with the Test Papers. The student should self-administer each paper under strict examination conditions and then compare his/her answers with the keys provided.

This Full-Syllabus Simulator Test Series, together with the 7 Final National Sit-down B.NET Series to be conducted in 17 cities between January and April 2010, should enable students to face Medical Entrance 2010 with supreme self-confidence.

**Test Centres**

The Enrolment Form lists the Centres for the B.NET Tests. Students should indicate the Centre of their choice of centre for the National Sit-down Tests.

**No change in the Centre will normally be allowed.** Any subsequent change in the Centre allotted will be considered only in exceptional cases and where the student applies to us in advance and receives our written approval.

Details of dates and venues for the B.NET Series will be mailed to students in advance.

Student will be eligible to attend these Tests only thirty days after the date of enrolment and may therefore miss one or more of the Tests in the B.NET Series, depending on their date of enrolment.

#### ***Doubt Letter Scheme***

Our Professors' services are readily available to clear students' doubts while studying our course material. Students can send us, in writing, their doubts, in the prescribed Doubt Letter Format, up to March 15th, 2009, even if our entire course material was received much earlier.

Problems must be restricted to five per letter and be well within the examination syllabus. The source from which the problems have been taken **must be specified** and student's **working sheets** enclosed with the problems being referred to us.

**Doubt Letters which do not meet these specific conditions will not be answered.**

#### ***Despatch of Lessons***

Despatch of Lesson Material for CBSE-PLUS 2010 begins in May 2008. Seven sets will be sent during the first year and the remaining seven sets during the second year, commencing in May 2009. Despatches are made at roughly monthly intervals and normally sent by Parcel Post or by private Courier Services.

For students who enrol after May 2008, course material already despatched till the date of enrolment will be sent in one lot. The material should be studied in chronological order.

### **Course Fee**

The fees for the CBSE-PLUS Course for Medical Entrance Examinations 2010 is **Rs. 10,600/-** + Service Tax Rs. 1,310/-. **Total: Rs. 11,910/-**.

Requests for fee concessions beyond those given on Pages 12 and 20, or for an instalment facility will not be entertained.
