Further, a Biology segment too is included as part of the course to meet the immediate requirements of the school Science curriculum, and also to help select the desired combination of subjects for the +2 course. Thus, Target:IIT has four segments – Mathematics, Physics, Chemistry and Biology.

Finally, on completing Target:IIT, our student will have a distinct advantage over other students, not only with regard to their performance in the Standard X Public Exam, but also in the preparatory courses for the Entrance Exams for admission to Engineering and allied courses.

COURSE HIGHLIGHTS

For whom intended

The course is intended for students of Stds. IX and X who are studying Mathematics, Physics, Chemistry and Biology in recognised schools.

Aim of the Course

The course builds a strong base effectively supplementing and expanding the knowledge acquired in school.

Nature of the Course

The following courses are offered:

- * Two-Year Target:IIT/Engg. Integrated Course: For students of Std. IX.
- * One-Year Target:IIT/Engg. Course-Part I: For students of Std. IX.
- * One-Year Target:IIT/Engg. Course-Part II: For students of Std. X.

All courses are Correspondence Courses and are in the English medium only.

Despatch of Lesson Material

The course lessons will be despatched on a monthly basis for the one-year course, in 5 Sets commencing in April 2008. Despatch of lesson material may be at shorter intervals for late enrolments, in order to complete the course on time. There will be a total of 10 lessons in each of the subjects: Maths, Physics, Chemistry and Biology. For the two-year course, there will be 5 sets during each year. The total number of lessons will be 20, covering both years.

The 6th Set

There will also be an additional 6th despatch for each year; it will not contain any lessons, but only solutions to the two Postal Test Papers.

Supplementary learning material

In addition to the course lessons, the following supplementary material is also provided for each of the classes, IX and X. They are: (i) Quiz (ii) A booklet titled “Makers of Modern Science” (iii) Glossary of

Technical Terms in Physics, Chemistry and Biology (iv) Practical Manuals both in Physics and in Chemistry – all meant to increase the sum total of the students’ knowledge of Mathematics and the Science subjects.

For Std X only

A brief resume of the Std. IX course material will also be sent with Set 1 to students of Std. X enrolling for Part II only.

Assignments

Each lesson in the 4 subjects includes an assignment or exercise for the student to answer at home, after careful study of the lesson itself. Solutions to these assignments will also be provided in the same set, so that the student can check his/her working against the solutions provided.

The assignments must NOT to be sent to us for correction as the solutions are already provided to the students.

Answers to the Quiz

Answers to the Quiz are not to be sent to us. The students themselves should check their correctness by referring to the solutions provided. Each Set will contain some Quiz items for which answers will also be included.

Postal Test Papers

There will be two Tests in the one-year course and four in the two-year course - 2 in each year. The Test Papers in each of the 4 subjects - Physics, Chemistry, Mathematics and Biology - should be answered by the students at home under strict examination conditions, and sent to us for correction. These will be evaluated and returned with the examiners’ remarks, if any.

Doubt Letter Scheme

If, with all the solutions provided, the student still finds any difficulty about any specific topic of the course material, he/she can make use of our Doubt Letter Scheme. The doubts referred to us will be cleared by our Professors and returned with the correct answers. The student must enclose their working sheets with their Doubt Letters.
